Dear Fish Campers (Class of 2013),

This is your official notification that you are confirmed to attend Fish Camp beginning Thursday, August 20th through Saturday August 22nd at YMCA Camp Cullen. **Please arrive at school by 10 AM, Thursday the 20th.** Please disregard any other times you may have seen online or any other places. You will need to bring a sack lunch and a drink for that day.

When you arrive by **10 AM** on Thursday, you will meet your counselor who will help you with the process of receiving your books, schedule, and locker assignment. Lunch will be around 1pm. At 2:15, you will meet with your principal, Mr. Moss, and around 2:30, you will start boarding the buses. Plan to return to the school shortly after 3 pm on Saturday the 22nd. Please make sure your rides are ready to pick you up from the school on time!

When you arrive on Thursday, have with you a completed Camp Cullen Liability Release Form, which can be found on the back of this letter. You must have this in order to attend Fish Camp. Even if you think you have already submitted a copy, **bring an additional copy with you to turn in on Thursday.** You will turn the form in to your counselor. You will not be able to attend Fish Camp if you do not have this form completely filled out and turned in on Thursday.


You will need to bring the following items to camp: a flashlight with fresh batteries, comfortable closed toe shoes such as tennis shoes or hiking boots (sandals of ANY type are not permitted), sleeping bag and/or sheets, a pillow, towels, insect repellent, toiletries (shampoo, soap, toothbrush, contact supplies, etc.) and enough tee shirts, underwear, shorts, jeans to last through two hot, sweaty days.

Please remember this is an HISD school trip, so the Student Code of Conduct must be followed at all times. Do not bring cigarettes, drugs, knives, guns, lighters, valuables, make up, jewelry, food, pets of any kind, pagers, stereos, iPods, cell phones, etc. If you are not sure about bringing something, leave it at home.
